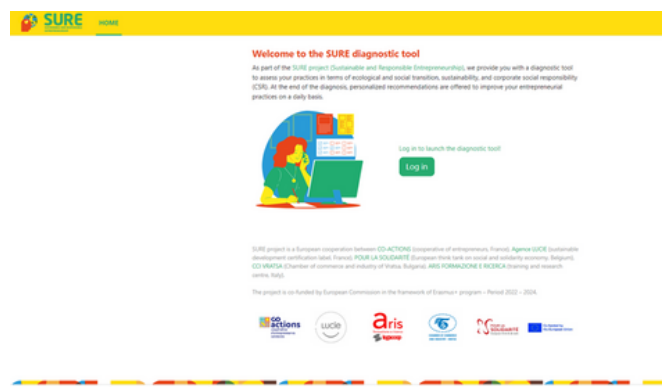

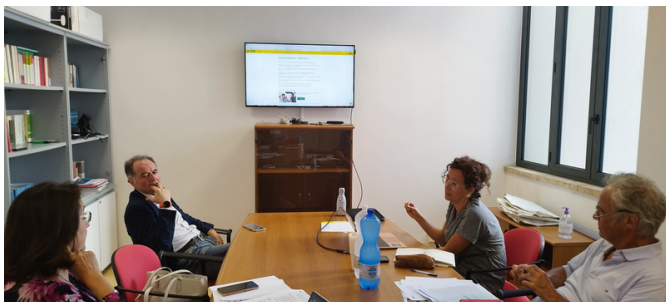


## Transnational meeting Italy

**PART 1:** Introduction to ecological transition context; Sustainable Development Goals; ISO 26 000; Global warming and planet boundaries.

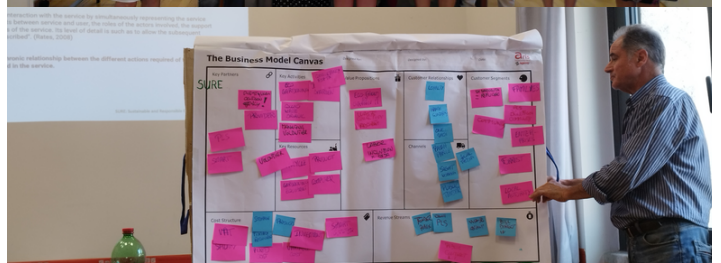
**PART 2:** Resistance to change and overcoming psychological barriers.

### Conference Corporate Social Responsibility 2023: Transition to sustainable business models

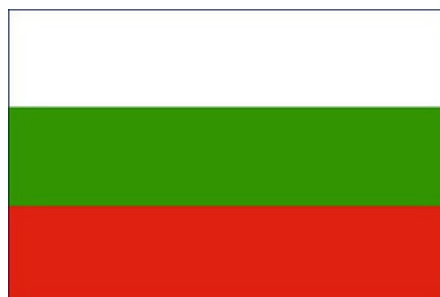
#### Description

**Description**

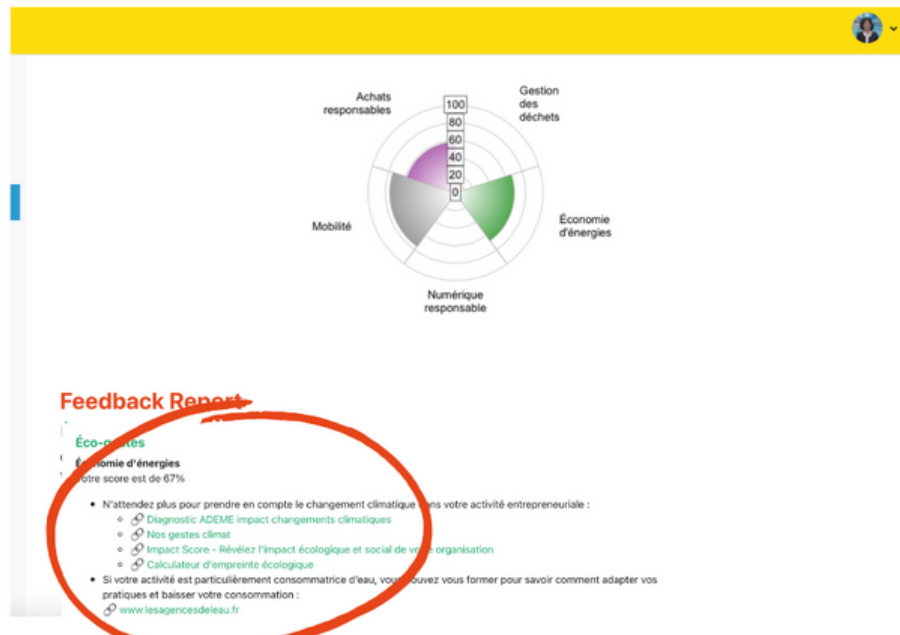
