

# 102 DEVELOPMENT OF TRAINING PROGRAM: TRAINING PROGRAMME FOR EMPLOYEES WORKING WITH UASC

The partnership has started working in the development of the training program. Each partner is now developing one training module of the course which is going to be integrated into a digital platform in the following months. The training program seeks to address the needs and gaps of knowledge and skills of professionals working with UASC (coordinators of reception centers, head of departments of local social services, trainers, persons responsible for training programs).



The consortium will develop a training program which will give professionals the right tools to:

- Address the specific needs of UASC and strengthen their resilience
- -Better tackle and facilitate the active participation of UASC in their acculturation process, their social integration and inclusion in the hosting communities
- Ensure proper, specific and uptodate information provided to UASC
- Facilitate peer to peer collaboration between UASC

The topics of the modules include: 1) Basic presentation of the UASCs context, 2) Legal framework at partner country level and general European framework, 3) Societal integration (school, work, etc.), 4) Intercultural competences, 5) Gender mainstreaming, equality, and non-discrimination, 6)Coping with the emotional problems of the minors, 7) Guardianship. Foster care. Coming of age.

















### 4TH TRANSNATIONAL PARTNERS MEETING


